WHY YOU NEED THIS

When seconds count, professional help is minutes away.

Massive bleeding can kill in 3–5 minutes. By the time EMS arrives, it can already be too late. The skills in this course were developed on the battlefield to address that exact gap — and they apply equally to **active-shooter incidents, vehicle crashes, hunting accidents, workplace injuries, and home emergencies**. No medical background required.

This is not a first aid course, and it is not the military's TCCC course. It is SkillCraft's civilian course built on the lifesaving principles of military Tactical Combat Casualty Care and STOP THE BLEED — adapted for the layperson.
